## **TESTING RESULTS**

- Met AYP (23 out of 23 Subgroups)
- High growth in all subjects.
- Greatest overall improvements in proficiency in both reading and math of all elementary schools in the Western Area.
- Every subgroup saw an increase in proficiency.
- 11% increase in overall proficiency.
- 12% increase in math proficiency.
- 92.5% of 4th graders proficient in math.
- Overall math proficiency higher than county average.
- Overall reading proficiency higher than county average.
- 9% increase in reading proficiency.
- 9% increase in science proficiency.
- 2% increase in attendance
- Closed the achievement gap by improving minority performance while maintaining/improving the performance of white students.
