

FALL 2011 SURVEY RESULTS FOR HILBURN DRIVE ACADEMY

Data and Accountability Department collected survey input from parents who might be impacted by changes for Hilburn Drive Elementary (now Hilburn Drive Academy). Results were shared with key leadership members to inform their decisionmaking. Multiple choice survey responses are attached.

Calendar Choice: *Parents selected the traditional calendar as their top choice.* Of the Hilburn Drive Elementary parents, 77% selected the traditional calendar, with 11% selecting a single-track and 8% selecting a multi-track year-round calendar; 3% had no preference (Item 5). For all parents responding, the percentage choosing the traditional calendar was lower but still the most popular (at 50%), with 15% selecting single-track and 32% selecting multi-track year-round calendars (Item 5). In addition, 92% of Hilburn Drive Elementary parents and 81% of all parents indicated a traditional calendar would be acceptable in a different question (Item 6). The acceptability of the other calendars was considerably lower. Most parents were not supportive of a different calendar for K-5 versus 6-8 based on several questions. Overall, 78% of Hilburn Drive and 52% of all parents indicated they would like their middle school students on a traditional calendar (Item 9). When asked how likely they would be to enroll their students in Hilburn Drive next year under various calendars, K-8 traditional was the top choice for 90% of Hilburn Drive parents and 49% of all parents surveyed – the highest percentage across the options (Item 11).

Start Time: *Parents preferred an earlier start time,* with 64% of Hilburn Drive and 79% of all parents selecting 8:15 or 8:30 versus 9:15 (Item 14). Hilburn Drive parents had a slight preference for 8:30 versus 8:15, with all parents combined being almost even on those two choices.

Program Offerings: Parents were asked about a variety of options for middle school; patterns were the same for Hilburn Drive parents and for all parents.

- Among the Career and Technical Education electives, *Keyboarding* was selected more often than Exploring Business Technology or Industrial Arts (Item 16).
- Among the languages listed, *Spanish* was selected much more often than French, German, or Chinese (Item 17).
- In the Visual and Performing Arts, *Art* was chosen more often than Chorus or Band (Item 18).
- Among the sports listed, *soccer* was more popular than football, volleyball, basketball, softball, or track. Basketball was the second choice for both groups (Item 19).
